HAVE YOUR PRESCRIPTION FILLED AT THE PHARMACY.

Day Before the Procedure:

- 1. DO NOT EAT.
- 2. Drink only clear liquids (no red or purple dye).

Acceptable: Water, coffee, tea, apple juice, white grape juice, soda such as Sprite, 7-UP and ginger ale, Jell-O, popsicles, broth and Gatorade or sports drinks.

- DO NOT drink milk or use non-dairy creamer. •
- DO NOT eat or drink anything colored red or purple. •
- DO NOT drink alcoholic beverages
- Hydration is important and it's part of the prep. Make sure to hydrate before you take the prep, while you're taking the prep and after the prep!

Evening Before the Procedure:

- 1. Drink ONE (1) bottle of CLENPIQ. Drink CLENPIQ right from the bottle.
- 2. Then keep hydrating. Drink at least 3 cups (8 oz. each) of clear liquid.

Day of the Procedure:

Four (4) hours before your scheduled procedure time, drink 2nd bottle of CLENPIQ plus at least 3 cups (8 oz. each) of 1. clear liquid, drinking 8 oz. every 15 minutes. For morning procedures, this means waking up very early, but it will ensure the best possible prep. Studies have shown that taking part of the prep the morning of the procedure gives the doctor the best possible view of the colon. A clean colon is essential for finding and removing polyps that may cause cancer. If the prep is excellent and no polyps are found, a colonoscopy may not be needed for 5-10 years.

IMPORTANT:

- 1 You will not be able to drive after your procedure. You will need a driver to stay during your procedure and to drive you home after the procedure.
- No Iron containing medication for at least one (1) week before the procedure. 2.
- 3. If you take Aspirin for heart protection, DO NOT STOP taking it.
- 4. If you take any medications for blood pressure, heart, seizure and/or anxiety: Please take these medications the morning of the exam with just sips of water.
- Before scheduling the procedure, please notify the doctor or nurse if you take any of the following medication: Diabetic 5. Medicine, Aspirin, Coumadin, Warfarin, Plavix or any blood thinner.
- Verbal and written instructions will be given to you and your driver after the procedure although you may not remember 6. due to the medications given at the time of your procedure.
