CALL TO ORDER

Chairman, Dan Duncan, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Weaver made a motion to approve the June 25, 2024, Board of Trustees minutes; June 21, 2024, Finance Committee minutes; and June 17, 2024, Medical Staff Integration Committee minutes as presented. Wilkinson seconded the motion and Barto, Duncan, Weaver, Clark, Wilkinson and Joyce voted in favor of the motion.

2024 ORGANIZATIONAL SCORECARD REPORT

CEO Webber shared the star rating in each category. Our quality rating from CMS remained at a 4-star. We saw a slight decrease in Inpatient Satisfaction scores, now 3-star, with 5-star in Outpatient Service and Growth. We are continuing performance improvement efforts in IP and ED.

ACCEPTANCE OF REPORTS FROM OFFICERS APPROVAL OF QUALITY ASSURANCE PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT (QAPI) REPORT

Necia Kimber shared the Clinical Performance Scorecard with the members. CMS is focusing on maternal outcomes. Many new measures are in place and are being tracked. Each Medical Staff Section will be reviewing the measures that affect their areas and working to make process improvements.

JUNE 2024 FINANCIAL REPORT/JULY FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Alan Lovelace provided a PowerPoint summary of operations for June 2024. Admissions, including rehab, were 377 below budget of 430, and last year of 393. Average Daily Census, including rehab was 47, compared to a budget

of 50 and last year of 52. Surgeries were 420 for the month, above last year of 414. Surgeries at the Surgery Center West were 554 for the month, below last year of 677.

Emergency room visits were 2,682 above last year of 2,505. Outpatient visits, not including ER visits, were 13,525 above last year of 13,064. Clinic Visits were 22,175 for the month, compared to last year of 22,954. Births were 50 for the month, compared to a budget of 67 and last year at 63.

Financial assistance was \$923,000 for the month. Salaries and Wages were at \$12.3M, above last year of \$10.8M. FTE's were 1,547 above last year of 1,491. Benefits were \$2.0M below budget of \$2.9M and last year of \$2.3M.

Operating Income Consolidated is \$928,000, above last year of \$289,000. Operating Income for the Hospitals is \$1.6M, above last year of \$860,000. Operating Income for Stillwater Medical in the month of June is \$1.4M, above last year of \$1.3M. Operating Income for Stillwater Medical Perry is \$107,000, above last year of (\$286,000). Operating Income for Stillwater Medical Blackwell is \$94,000, above last year of (\$232,000). Operating Income for the Clinics is (\$723,000) compared to last year of (\$571,000).

Operating Income for the Hospitals year to date is \$7.0M compared to a budget of \$8.4M and last year of \$5.3M. Operating Income for the Clinics year to date is (\$3.5M) compared to last year of (\$3.93M). Operating Margin for the Hospitals is 5.54% compared to last year of 4.75%. Operating Margin for the Clinics is -6.2% compared to a budget of -7.0% and last year -7.5%.

YTD Operating Margin Consolidated is 1.91%, compared to a budget of 2.59% and last year of 0.84%. YTD Non-Operating Revenue is \$3.1M, below last year at \$8.4M. YTD Net Income Consolidated is \$6.6M, above budget of \$5.6M and below last year of \$8.4M.

The BancFirst investment account decreased to \$83.8M and year to date is 3.15%. The Arvest investment account increased to \$9.79M and year to date is 3.99%. The Commerce investment account increased to \$16.1M and year to date is 5.69%. Consolidated Investments for June is \$109.8M.

Days in Accounts Receivable is 39 days. Cash Collections-AR only for June was \$24.5M compared to \$22.8M in the 1st quarter. Net AR Balance Consolidated in June was \$53.4M. Cash on hand is \$120.1M compared to \$139M at year end 2023. A YTD Operating Income Summary vs Budget and Investment Bank Performance was provided.

Lovelace shared that the Finance Committee reviewed the financials and summary of clinic operations. Arvest presented SMC's investment portfolio update.

Clark made a motion to accept the standing reports. Barto seconded the motion, and Wilkinson, Duncan, Weaver, Joyce, Clark and Barto voted in favor of the motion.

SEMI-ANNUAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST STATEMENT

The Conflict-of-Interest statement is completed semi-annually and filed with the Secretary of State. Signatures were secured from the Board members present.

CONSENT AGENDA

Dan Duncan updated the Board members on all Consent Agenda items for Stillwater Medical Center and Rural Emergency Hospitals in Blackwell and Perry. All actions listed on the consent agenda were approved through our Medical Staff Committees.

Barto moved the Board approve the Consent Agenda with the removal of one item, "a. lxii, RI Advance Medical Directives." Clark seconded the motion and Wilkinson, Weaver, Joyce, Barto, Clark and Duncan voted in favor of the motion.

ITEMS REMOVED FROM THE CONSENT AGENDA

Barto made a motion to change the RI Advance Medical Directives policy (a. lxii) wording from "Oklahoma Law" to "Oklahoma Advance Directive Act." Clark seconded the motion and Clark, Barto, Joyce, Weaver, Wilkinson and Duncan voted in favor of the motion.
